

Northeast Region Youth Staff Development Course 2006 YSDC Registration Information



Participant Qualifications:

This course is for Boy Scouts who meet the following qualifications:

- First Class rank or above
- Fourteen years of age by the opening day of course, but not yet 18
- Have completed your council National Youth Leader Training (NYLT or JLT). If your council does not have a youth leader training program, you may still qualify by working with a council representative to become familiar with the NYLT Staff Guide
- Be or becoming a youth leader trainer for your council
- Be proficient in scoutcraft skills such as rope work, camping, hiking, cooking, compass, etc.
- Willing to take back to your council YLT program the knowledge and skills acquired at YSDC

Fees: The course fee will be \$250 per participant. If an application is received by May 1, 2006 with full payment, a discount of \$25 will be awarded for a total Early Bird Fee of \$225 per participant.

Activities:

While attending YSDC you will be engaged in a full program with a wide variety of activities including:

- Lashing, rope work and advanced pioneering projects
- Creating realistic first aid wounds
- Cooking
- Learning how to prepare for a presentation
- Making presentations on various topics (you will make 5 presentations)
- Using the NYLT Leadership Tools
- Learning about and living the concepts of “Ethics in Action” and “Servant Leadership”

The focus of this program is primarily on improving presentation and evaluation skills.

Physical Conditioning

You will be engaged in strenuous physical activities and you will need to be in top physical condition to get the most from this program. You will need a complete physical that has been performed within the year of the last day of the course. A Health and Medical Form will be included in your information packet. You cannot participate without a physician-signed Medical Form.

Camp and Camp Living

The YSDC program will be conducted at Yard’s Creek Scout Reservation off Interstate 80 near the Delaware River Gap. You will sleep in large two-person wall tents with a wooden floor with cots and foam mattresses. Bring your own sleeping bag and bedding. You and your training patrol will prepare some of the meals during the course. Showers and other facilities will be available.

Uniform

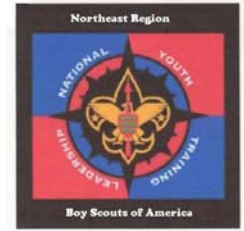
The official Boy Scout summer uniform is required with insignia that you normally wear. The activity uniform, worn during the afternoon on most days, consists of Scout shorts, YSDC cap and YSDC T-shirt (furnished by the course), Scout socks and belt. You will not wear street clothes during the course, and you should report to the course in a complete field uniform.
